Olney Days Request for Partnership Waste Management for Olney Days 2024

Issue to Address

Olney Days Party in the Park will be held in Olney Manor Park on Saturday, April 27, 2024 which expects approximately 8000 people. To reduce our carbon footprint, we are striving to be a zero waste event in which waste is either recycled or composted. This means the waste stream needs to be sorted before it is "thrown away."

Olney Civic Fund's Vision

Olney Civic Fund (OCF) envisions that an organization from the Olney area with ample volunteers and adult leadership will respond. On the day of the event, the organization will have the leadership structure and sufficient youth and adults to execute supervision of waste management with no additional support from OCF. Before Olney Days weekend, an OCF representative will walk the site with the organization's leadership to review the supplies, location of waste collection sites, and discussion of how to sort the waste stream.

Requirements

Olney Civic Fund will provide 8 recycling, waste, and compost containers to be placed throughout the event space. The group will provide at least 2 volunteers per waste collection site (minimum 16 people) to accept waste from the public and sort into the correct containers. Waste at this event is primarily from food and beverage so most of it is compostable. The group will also move full containers to a designated storage site at the event. One of the waste collection sites needs to be mobile and move throughout the event picking up waste left by event attendees. Event is 3:00 - 8:00 pm and the group should plan to stay until all waste is picked up and moved to the storage sites (this can take an additional 2 hours depending on number of volunteers). Party in the Park is a rain or shine event. The minimum requirement is 20 volunteers of which there are at least 4 adults.

In addition, the organization will provide at least 4 people, including at least 2 adults, for inspection on Sunday, April 28 at 8:00 am. If there are any areas that need additional cleanup the organization will perform the cleanup at that time.
